


How to draw Simon


STEP 1

to the bottom.




STEP 3

and a mouth.




STEP 4

PATTERN MAKING

Once there was a little ghost who was a quilt. He was made with a whole bunch of squares sewn together. Help complete the quilt below by filling in the empty squares with your own designs and colors.



LOLLIPOP GHOSTS

STEP-BY-STEP

In *The Little Ghost Who was a Quilt*, the little ghost sees a branch trimmed with lollipop ghosts. If you have extra fabric, you can make a whole family of lollipop ghosts — maybe there's even a lace one like the little ghost's great-grandmother! Ghosts can be all shapes, sizes and colors.

WHAT YOU'LL NEED:

- Different types of fabric (any pattern)
- Round lollipops
- A marker
- String or ribbons

STEP 1:

Cut your fabric so it is about the size of a tissue.

STEP 2:

Place the cut fabric over the lollipop (make sure the lollipop is still wrapped up so your ghost does not get sticky!)

STEP 3:

Add a ribbon or string around the base of the lollipop so that there's a separate head and body.

STEP 4:

Draw eyes and a mouth onto your ghost's head.

STEP 5:

Decorate! Put your lollipop ghosts in a container or hang them on a branch.



Make Your Own Witch's Hat



What you'll need:

- a paper plate
- tape
- a paper hat (with an elastic string)
- a pen or marker
- scissors
- ruler
- decorations: paint, markers, stickers, glitter glue, etc.

Step 1: Place the paper hat on the paper plate and trace the bottom of the hat on the plate. Now, make another circle within the one you just traced – leave about 1/2-inch space between the two circles. Next, cut along the smaller circle (poking a hole in the center of the paper plate can help with this!)

Step 2: Now, cut multiple 3/4-inch slits along the bottom of the paper hat.

Step 3: Bend the slits outward, all in the same direction, giving a skirt-like appearance to the hat.

Step 4: Pull the top of the hat through the hole in the paper plate you made in Step 1 – making sure the hat's elastic isn't tangled.

Now, tape the slits to the plate to hold the two together.

Step 5: Use the paint, markers, stickers etc to decorate your hat.

Now you have your own witch's hat!




The Witching Hour

DECORATE YOUR OWN JAM JAR

WHAT YOU'LL NEED:

- An old, clean, jam jar
- Cutouts of the strawberry labels provided
- Some tissue paper (any color)
- Liquid glue
- A paint brush

STEP 1:

With all your items prepped to use, take the glue and start applying it onto the jar using the paint brush.

STEP 2:

Next, start placing pieces of tissue paper onto the jar. These can be placed in any way that you'd like.

STEP 3:

Once the jar is covered, apply another layer of glue onto the tissue paper. This will set this layer in place.

STEP 4:

Now it's time to add your strawberry labels to the jar. Place the labels anywhere on the jar and apply another layer of glue over them.

Once the glue dries, you'll have your own jam jar. Make sure you keep it safely, away from
