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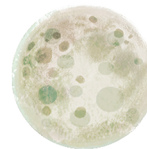
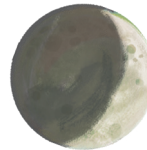


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MATCHING

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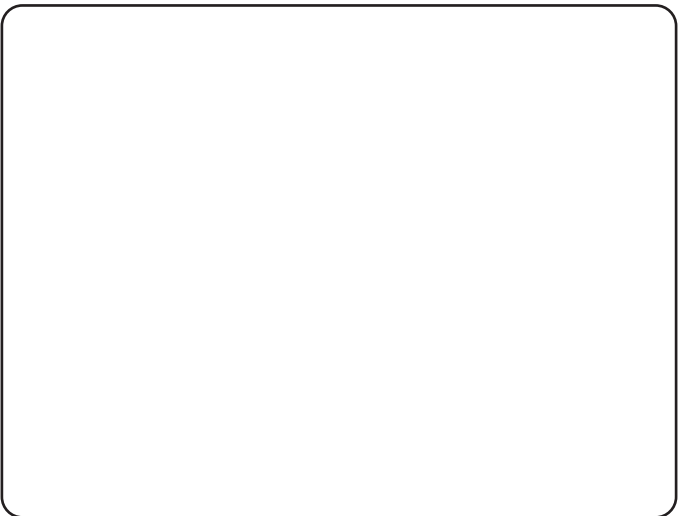
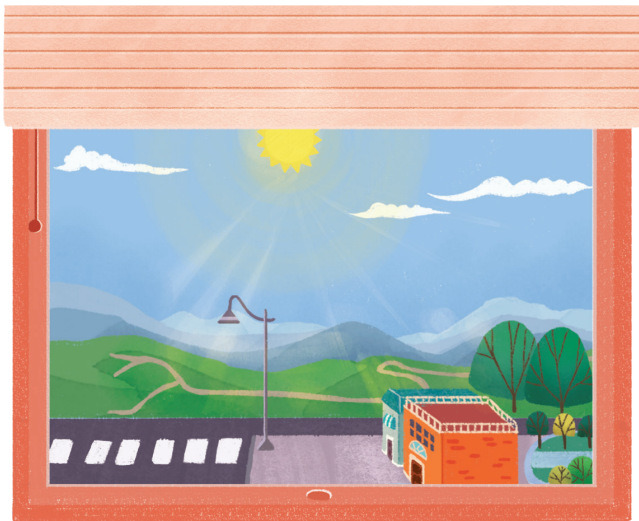
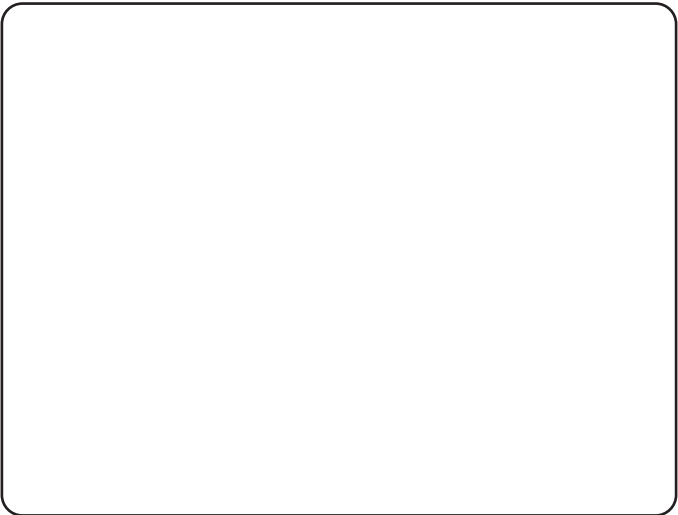


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WEATHER

In *Manny Matches the Weather*, Manny's outfits do not always match the weather. Look at the weather featured in each window below and draw items of clothing that match each one.



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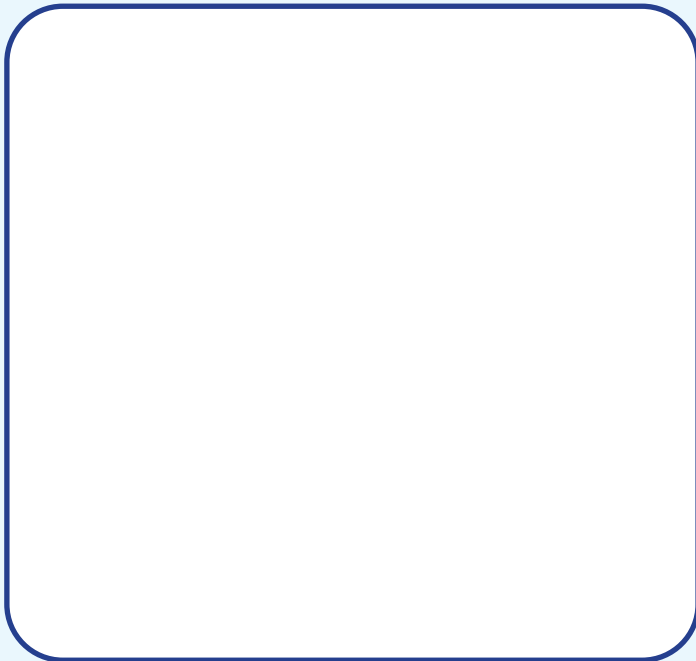
DESIGN
