SYMBOLS AND ABBREVIATIONS

- Ⓞ magic ring
- chain (**ch**)
- slip stitch (**sl st**)
- + double crochet (**dc**)

TOOLS AND MATERIALS

Yarn used: Small amounts of cotton DK (8-ply/light worsted) yarn in the following colours: cornflower blue (yarn A), peony (yarn B), honeysuckle (yarn C)

Hooks used: 4mm (8 UK, 6 US) crochet hook

Block Size: 15 x 15cm (6 x 6in)

PATTERN INSTRUCTIONS

Starting ch counts as a st, unless stated otherwise.

Round 1: using yarn A and working into a magic ring, 2 ch, 7 htr, join with sl st to top of 2-ch (8 sts).

Round 2: *5 ch (does not count as st), 1 dc in third ch from hook, 1 tr in next ch, 1 htr in next ch, sl st to next st; rep from * eight times (24 sts).

Fasten off yarn A.

Round 3: attach yarn B to a dc st, *[3 ch, 2 tr] in dc, 2 tr, sl st to next dc; rep from * eight times, join with a sl st to base of 3-ch (40 sts).

Fasten off yarn B.

Round 4: attach yarn C to top of 3-ch, *3 ch, 3 tr, 2 tr in next st, sl st to top of 3-ch; rep from * eight times, join with a sl st to base of first 3-ch (48 sts).

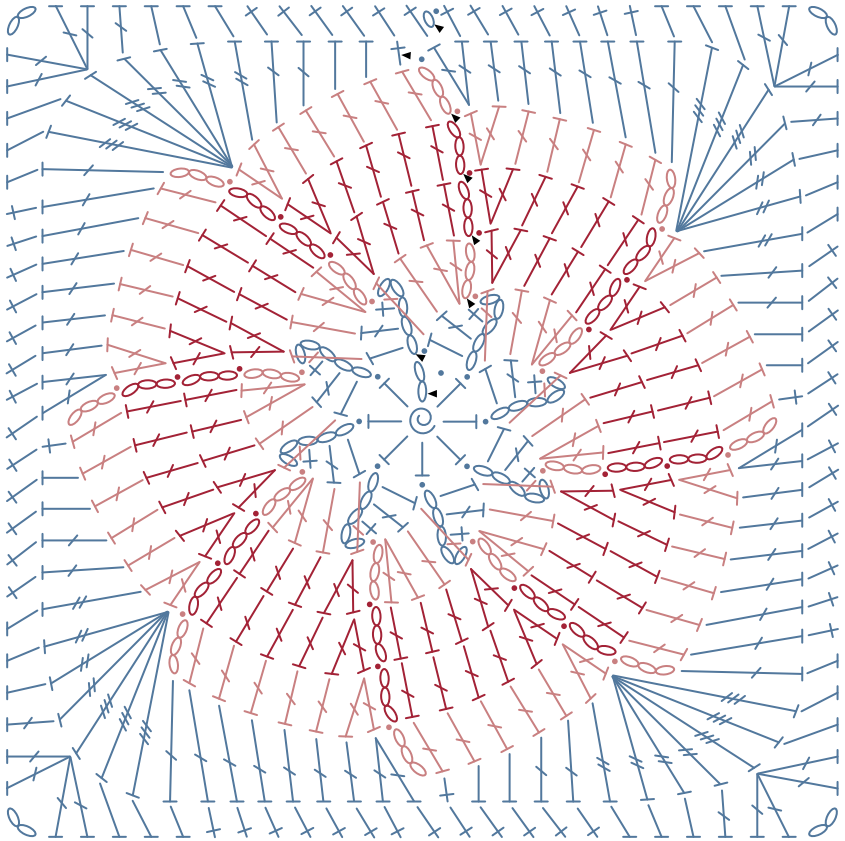
Round 5: 3 sl st up to top of round 4 starting ch, *3 ch, 4 tr, 2 tr in next st, sl st to top of 3-ch, rep from * eight times, join with sl st to base of first 3-ch (56 sts).

Fasten off yarn C.

Round 6: attach yarn B to top of 3-ch, *3 ch, 5 tr, 2 tr in next st, sl st to top of 3-ch, rep from * eight times, join with sl st to base of first 3-ch (64 sts).

Fasten off yarn B.

Round 7: attach yarn A to top of 3-ch, *1 dc in next st, 2 htr, 2 tr, 1 dtr, [3 dtr, 3 trtr] in next st, 1 tr in top of 3-ch, 6 tr, 2 tr in next st, sl st to top of 3-ch, rep from * four times (84 sts).



Round 8: 1 ch (does not count as st), 6 dc, 3 htr, 1 tr, [2 tr, 2 ch, 2 tr] in next st, 1 tr, 3 htr, 13 dc, rep from * three times, 3 htr, 1 tr, [2 tr, 2 ch, 2 tr] in next st, 1 tr, 3 htr, 7 dc, join with sl st to beg st (100 sts).
Fasten off.

TECHNIQUES USED

Working into end of rows

TOOLS AND MATERIALS

Yarn used: Small amounts of cotton DK (8-ply/light worsted) yarn in the following colours: peony (yarn A) , honeysuckle (yarn B)

Hooks used: 4mm (8 UK, 6 US) crochet hook

Block Size: 15 x 15cm (6 x 6in)

PATTERN INSTRUCTIONS

Starting ch does not count as a st, unless stated otherwise.

Using yarn A, chain 21.

Row 1: starting in third ch from hook, 19 tr, turn (19 sts).

Row 2: 2 ch, 9 tr, 4 ch, miss 1, 9 tr, turn (18 sts).

Row 3: 2 ch, 7 tr, 3 ch, miss 2, 1 dc in 4-ch sp, 3 ch, miss 2, 7 tr, turn (15 sts).

Row 4: 2 ch, 5 tr, 4 ch, miss 2, 1 dc in third ch, 1 dc, 1 dc in first ch, 4 ch, miss 2, 5 tr, turn (13 sts).

Row 5: 2 ch, 3 tr, 5 ch, miss 2, 1 dc in fourth ch, 3 dc, 1 dc in first ch, 5 ch, miss 2, 3 tr, turn (11 sts).

Row 6: 2 ch, 1 tr, 6 ch, miss 2, 1 tr in fifth ch, 5 tr, 1 tr in first ch, 6 ch, miss 2, 1 tr, turn (9 sts).

Row 7: 2 ch, 1 tr, 1 tr in first and second ch, 5 ch, miss 1, 5 dc, 5 ch, miss 1, 1 tr in fifth and sixth ch, 1 tr, turn (11 sts).

Row 8: 2 ch, 3 tr, 1 tr in first and second ch, 4 ch, miss 1, 3 dc, 4 ch, miss 1, 1 tr in fourth and fifth ch, 3 tr, turn (13 sts).

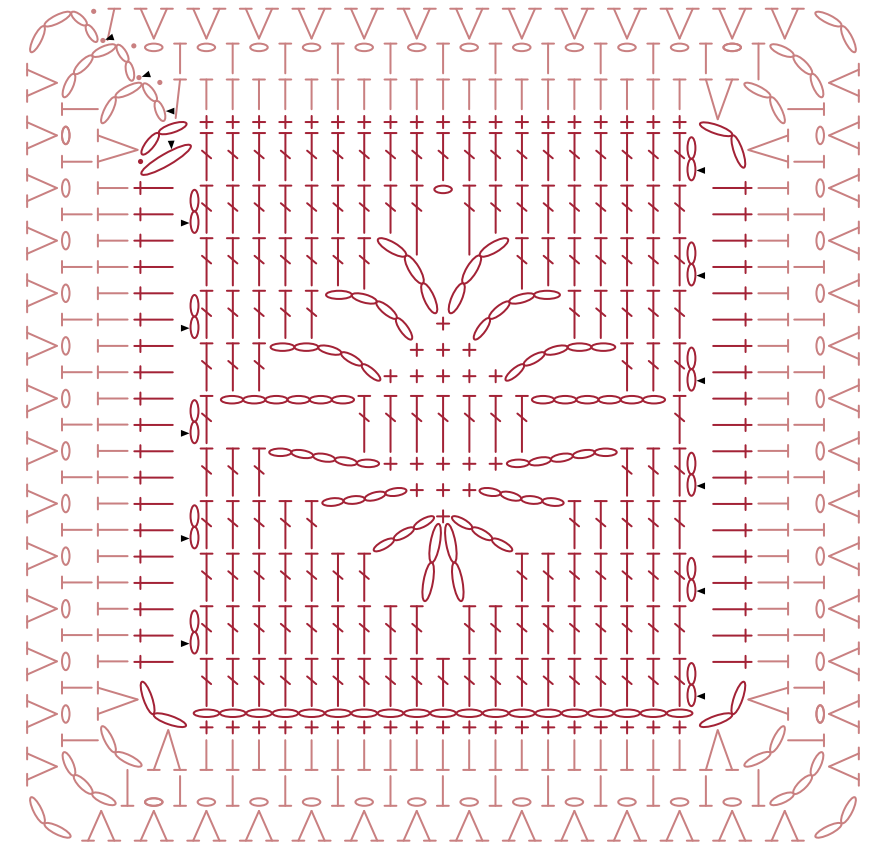
Row 9: 2 ch, 5 tr, 1 tr in first and second ch, 3 ch, miss 1, 1 dc, 3 ch, miss 1, 1 tr in third and fourth ch, 5 tr, turn (15 sts).

Row 10: 2 ch, 7 tr, 1 tr in first and second ch, 1 ch, miss dc, 1 tr in second and third ch, 7 tr, turn (18 sts).

Row 11: 2 ch, 19 tr, do not fasten off (19 sts).

BORDER

Round 1: 1 ch, [rotate square to work along row ends, 19 dc evenly spaced along edge, 2 ch, rotate square, 19 dc, 2 ch] twice, join



with sl st to first dc (76 sts).

Fasten off yarn A.

Round 2: attach yarn B to corner 2-ch sp, 4 ch (counts as 1 htr, 2 ch), 2 htr in 2-ch sp, *19 htr, [2 htr, 2 ch, 2 htr] in 2-ch sp, rep from * three times, 19 htr, 1 htr before starting ch in 2-ch sp, join with sl st to second ch of starting ch (92 sts).

Round 3: sl st to corner 2-ch sp, 5 ch (counts as 1 htr, 3 ch), 1 htr in 2-ch sp, *1ch, miss 1, [1 htr, 1 ch, miss 1] eleven times, [1 htr, 3 ch, 1 htr] in 2-ch sp, rep from * three times, 1ch, miss 1, [1 htr, 1 ch, miss 1] eleven

times, , join with sl st to second ch of starting ch (52 sts).

Round 4: sl st to corner 3-ch sp, 4 ch (counts as 1 htr, 2 ch), 2 htr in 3-ch sp, *[miss 1, 2 htr in 1-ch sp] twelve times, miss 1, [2 htr, 2 ch, 2 htr] in corner 3-ch sp; rep from * three times, [miss 1, 2 htr in 1-ch sp] twelve times, miss 1, 1 htr before starting ch in 3-ch sp, join with sl st to second ch of starting ch (112 sts). Fasten off.

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SUNSET SKIES

TOOLS AND MATERIALS

Yarn used: Small amounts of cotton DK (8-ply/light worsted) yarn in the following colours: vibrant orange (yarn A), aqua (yarn B), major teal (yarn C)

Hooks used: 4mm (8 UK, 6 US) crochet hook

Block Size: 15 x 15cm (6 x 6in)

HINTS AND TIPS

ch 1 in the corners creates a granny square with smaller gaps, but if you prefer a looser granny square, you can replace the corner 1-ch to 2-ch, although it will make your square slightly larger.

PATTERN INSTRUCTIONS

Starting ch counts as a st, unless stated otherwise.

Round 1: using yarn A and working into a magic ring, 4 ch (counts as 1 tr, 1 ch), [3 tr, 1 ch] three times, 2 tr, join with a sl st to third ch of starting ch (12 sts).

Round 2: sl st to 1-ch sp, 4 ch (counts as 1 tr, 1 ch), 3 tr in same ch sp, [3 tr, 1 ch, 3 tr] in next 1-ch sp three times, 2 tr in 1-ch sp next to starting ch, join with sl st to third ch of starting ch (24 sts).

Rounds 3–6: sl st to 1-ch sp, 4 ch (counts as 1 tr, 1 ch), 3 tr in same ch-sp, *3 tr between each of the clusters of 3 tr, [3 tr, 1 ch, 3 tr] in corner 1-ch sp, rep from * three times, 3 tr between each cluster of 3 tr, 2 tr in 1-ch sp next to starting ch, join with sl st to third ch of starting ch (72 sts). Fasten off yarn A.

TRIANGLES

Row 1: (RS) attach yarn B to any corner 1-ch sp, 3 ch, 3 tr between each cluster of 3 tr, 1 tr in next corner 1-ch sp, turn (17 sts).

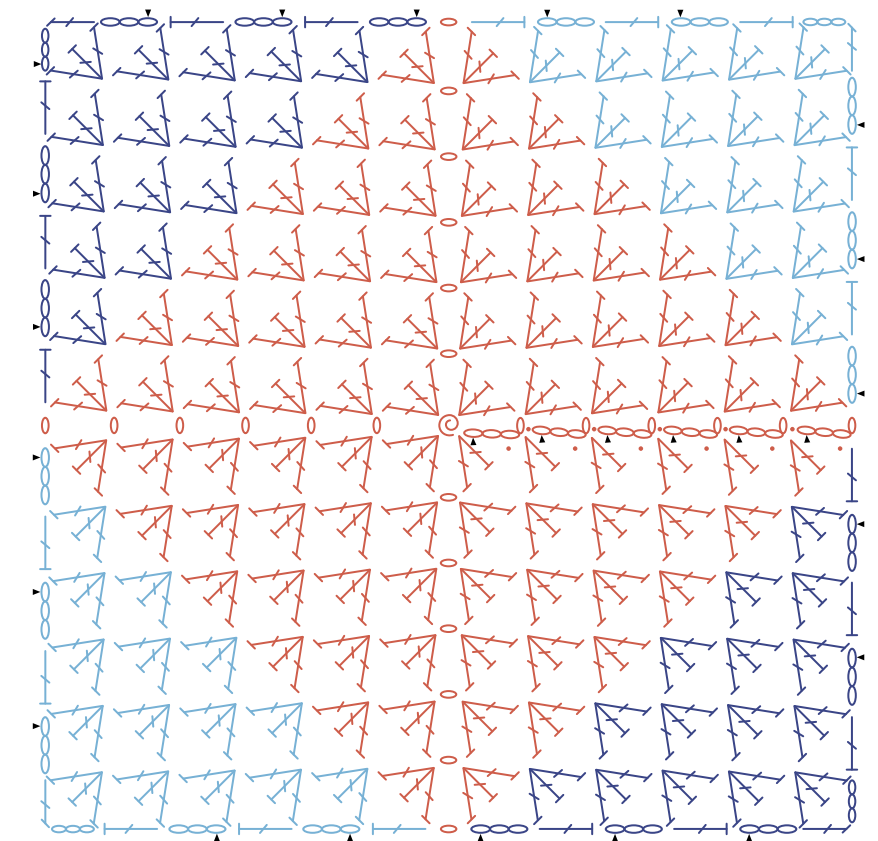
Rows 2–5: 3 ch, 3 tr between each cluster of 3 tr, 1 tr in 3-ch sp, turn (5 sts).

Row 6: 3 ch, 1 tr in 3-ch sp (2 sts).

Fasten off yarn B.

Repeat rows 1– 6 on opposite corner.

Using yarn C, repeat rows 1–6 on two remaining corners.

TOOLS AND MATERIALS

Yarn used: Small amounts of cotton DK (8-ply/light worsted) yarn in the following colours: gold (yarn A), sunshine (yarn B), aqua (yarn C), major teal (yarn D)

Hooks used: 4mm (8 UK, 6 US) crochet hook

Block Size: 15 x 15cm (6 x 6in)

SPECIAL STITCHES

puff stitch (ps): [yrh, insert hook into st, yrh, pull up a loop] five times into same stitch, yrh, draw through all 11 loops on hook.

double crochet 2 together (dc2tog): [insert hook into next st, yrh, pull up a loop] twice, yrh, draw through all 3 loops on hook.

PATTERN INSTRUCTIONS

Starting ch does not count as a st, unless stated otherwise.

Round 1: using yarn A and working into a magic ring, 1 ch, 8 dc, join with sl st to beg st (8 sts).

Round 2: [1 ps, 1 ch] eight times, join with sl st to beg st (8 sts).

Round 3: sl st to 1-ch sp, 1 ch, [1 dc in 1-ch sp, 3 ch] eight times, join with a sl st to beg st (8 sts).

Round 4: *[1 dc, 1 htr, 1 tr, 3 ch, 1 tr, 1 htr, 1 dc] in 3-ch sp, sl st to dc, rep from * eight times, join with a sl st to beg sl st (48 sts). Fasten off yarn A.

Round 5: attach yarn B to second ch of 3-ch loop, 1 ch, *1 dc in second ch of 3-ch loop, 2 ch, [1 dtr, 1 trtr, 2 ch, 1 trtr, 1 dtr] in sl st, 2 ch, rep from * eight times, join with sl st to beg st (40 sts). Fasten off yarn B.

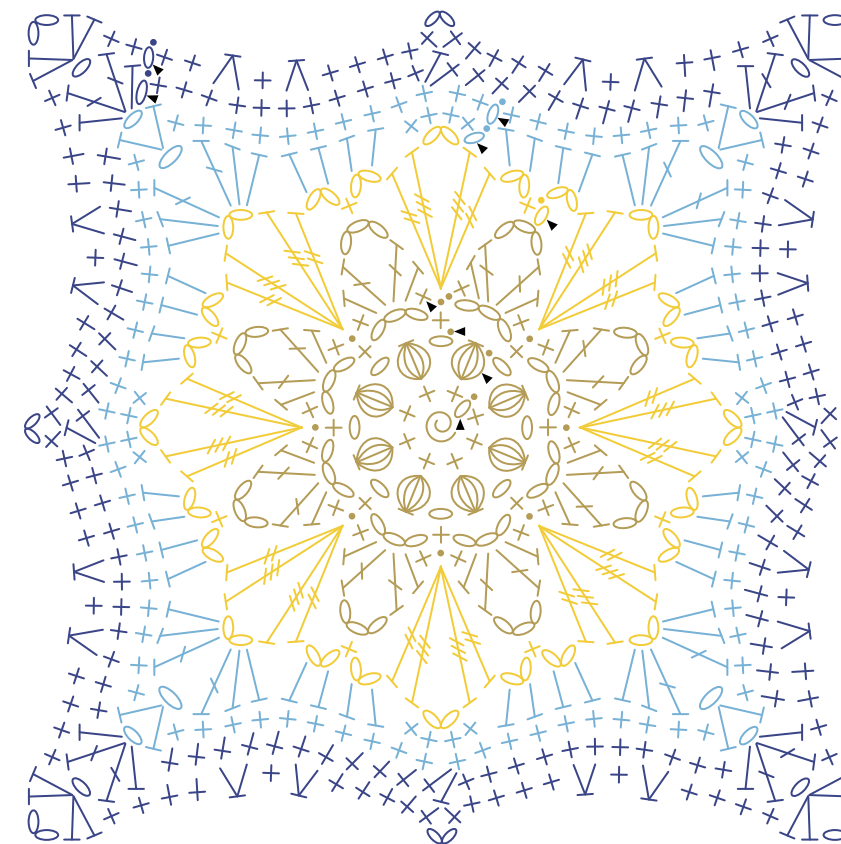
Round 6: attach yarn C to 2-ch sp between two trtr, 1 ch, *4 dc in 2-ch sp, [2 htr in next 2-ch sp] twice, [2 htr, 1 tr, 1 ch, 1 tr, 2 htr] in next 2-ch sp, [2 htr in next 2-ch sp] twice, rep from * four times, join with a sl st to beg st (72 sts).

Round 7: 1 ch, 11 dc, *[1dc, 1 htr, 1 ch, 1 htr, 1dc] in corner 1-ch sp, 18 dc, rep from * three times, [1dc, 1 htr, 1 ch, 1 htr, 1 dc] in corner 1-ch sp, 7 dc, join with a sl st to beg st (88 sts). Fasten off yarn C.

Round 8: attach yarn D to any corner 1-ch sp, 1 ch, *[1 htr, 1 tr, 1 ch, 1 tr, 1 htr] in 1-ch sp, miss 1, 10 dc, [1 dc, 1 htr, 1 dc] in next st,

10 dc, rep from * four times, join with a sl st to beg st (108 sts).

Round 9: 1 ch, 2 dc, *[2 htr, 2 ch, 2 htr] in corner 1-ch sp, 4 dc, dc2tog, 1 dc, dc2tog, 4 dc, [1 dc, 2 ch, 1 dc] in next st, 4 dc, dc2tog, 1 dc, dc2tog, 4 dc, rep from * three times, [2 htr, 2 ch, 2 htr] in corner 1-ch sp, 4 dc, dc2tog, 1 dc, dc2tog, 4 dc, [1 dc, 2 ch, 1 dc] in next st, 4 dc, dc2tog, 1 dc, dc2tog, 2 dc, join with a sl st to beg st (112 sts). Fasten off.



HINTS AND TIPS

If you would like to join these motifs you can join them in the chain stitches that are in each of the points, creating a decorative gap between squares...

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CHANGING LEAVES

- chain (ch)
- slip stitch (sl st)
- + double crochet (dc)
- T half treble crochet (htr)
- ⏏ double treble crochet (dtr)
-  4 double treble cluster (4dtrcl)
- ▶ beginning of row or round right side (RS)

TECHNIQUES USED

Working into row ends

TOOLS AND MATERIALS

Yarn used: Small amounts of cotton DK (8-ply/light worsted) yarn in the following colours: wine (yarn A), tangerine (yarn B), rich gold (yarn C), kiwi (yarn D), juniper (yarn E)

Hooks used: 4mm (8 UK, 6 US) crochet hook

Block Size: 15 x 15cm (6 x 6in)

SPECIAL STITCHES

4 double treble cluster (4dtrcl): *yrh twice, insert hook into st, yrh, pull up a loop, [yrh, draw through 2 loops] twice; rep from * four times in same st, yrh, draw through all 5 loops on hook.

PATTERN INSTRUCTIONS

Starting ch counts as a st, unless stated otherwise.

Using yarn A, chain 28.

Row 1 (RS): starting in third ch from hook (first 2 ch count as first htr), 26 htr, turn (27 sts).

Row 2: 5 ch (counts as 1 dtr, 1 ch), miss 1, [4dtrcl, 1 ch, miss 1] twelve times, 1 dtr in top of starting ch, turn (14 sts).

Row 3: 1 ch (does not count as st), [2 dc in 1-ch sp] thirteen times, 1 dc in fourth ch of starting ch, turn (27 sts).

Fasten off yarn A.

Rows 4–5: attach yarn B to first dc, 1 ch, 27 dc, turn (27 sts).

Row 6: as row 2.

Row 7: as row 3.

Fasten off yarn B.

Rows 8–9: attach yarn C to first dc and work as rows 4 and 5.

Row 10: as row 2.

Row 11: as row 3.

Fasten off yarn C.

Rows 12–13: attach yarn D to first dc and work as rows 4 and 5.

Row 14: as row 2.

Row 15: as row 3.

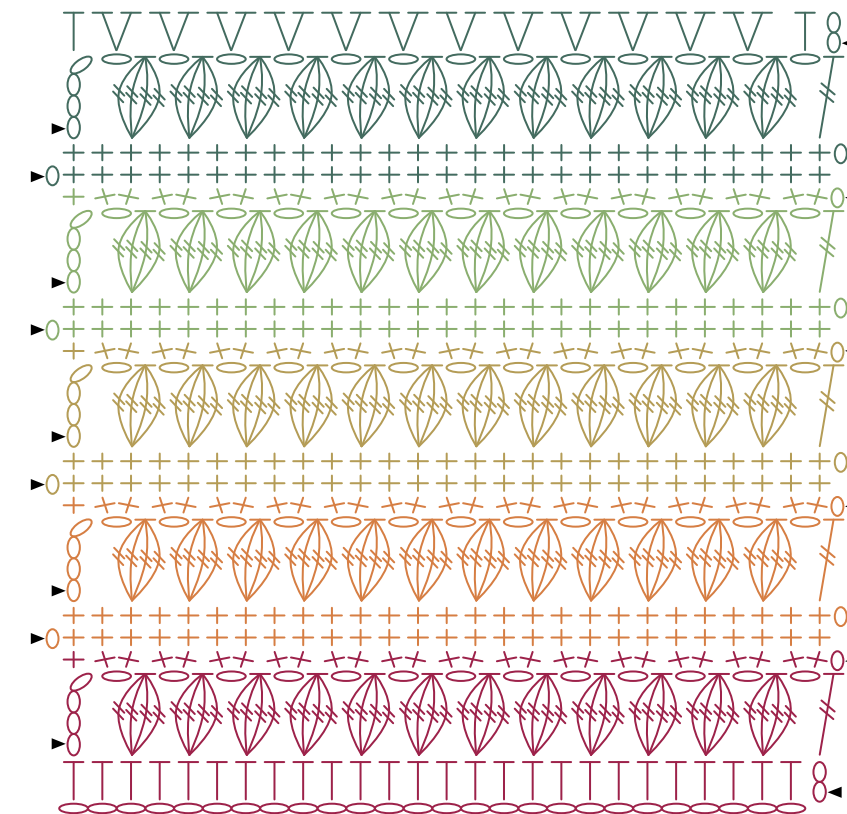
Fasten off yarn D.

Rows 16–17: attach yarn E to first dc and work as rows 4 and 5.

Row 18: as row 2.

Row 19: 2 ch, 1 htr in 1-ch sp, [2 htr in 1-ch sp] twelve times, 1 htr in fourth ch of starting ch (27 sts).

Fasten off yarn E.



HINTS AND TIPS

Option to add a border: evenly place 27 dc along each side, with 2 ch for the corners.
